Federal, state, and local regulations require certain industries to establish and implement a number of environmental programs. We have extensive experience in RCRA, CERCLA, NPDES, TSCA and EPCRA environmental programs.

Permitting

Contingency Plan Preparation

FTS helps clients determine which specific environmental contingency plans are needed for their facility. FTS Compliance Specialists are proficient at preparing contingency plans to prevent and control potential leaks or spills of materials harmful to humans or the environment. These plans include Preparedness, Prevention, and Contingency (PPC) plans for large quantity generators of hazardous waste, Small Quantity Generator Procedures for small quantity generators of hazardous waste, Spill Prevention, Control, and Countermeasure (SPCC) plans for facilities that store or use oil, and Stormwater Pollution Prevention (SWPP) plans for stormwater discharges.

Hazardous Chemical Inventory Reporting

Under EPCRA, facilities that use or store hazardous materials in certain quantities are required to submit an annual inventory report. Our Compliance Specialists are well versed in EPCRA regulations and can conduct a usage and inventory review to determine if hazardous material quantities require reporting.
